* Differential Diagnosis :-

1] Iron Deficiency Anaemia :-

It is commonest cause of anaemia. Cause of Microcytic hypochromic in which all 3 red cell indices i.e. MCV, MCH and MCHC are reduced due to defective Hb synthesis.

Pathogenesis :- Iron deficiency anaemia develops when the supply of iron is inadequate for the requirement of haemoglobin synthesis.

Factors :- ① Inadequate dietary intake

② Increased dietary intake

③ Decreased intestinal absorption

④ Increased blood loss

Clinical features → Weakness, fatigue, dyspnoea on exertion, palpitation and pallor of skin, mucous membrane and sclera.

2) Megaloblastic Anaemia :-

Megaloblastic anaemia are associated with macrocytic blood picture. In this type of anaemia macrocytic red cells are seen and there is increased MCV & MCH values and normal or reduced MCHC.

Pathologic factors :- ① Inadequate dietary intake

eg:- strict vegetarians

② Malabsorption :- Gastric & Intestinal Cause

Sources - The only dietary sources of vitamin B₁₂ are food of animal protein origin, such as kidney, liver, heart muscles meat, fish, egg and vegetarian. Daily requirement of B₁₂ → 2-4 µg.

Absorption → Vitamin B₁₂ in food is released and forms a stable complex to gastric R-binder (glycoprotein). Absorbed in duodenum and upper jejunum.

Clinical features - ① The onset is gradually insidious

② Glossitis - Patient has beefy red tongue

③ Neurologic - degeneration of spinal cord and peripheral neuropathy; numbness, paraesthesia, weakness, ataxia, poor fingers co-ordination and diminished reflexes.

④ Other - Mild Jaundice, angular stomatitis, purpura, melanin pigmentation, malabsorption, weight loss, anorexia.

3]. Hypothyroidism:-

This condition is also called overactive thyroid. That can cause weight loss, hand tremors and rapid or irregular heartbeat, nervousness, irritability, trouble sleeping, fatigue, muscle weakness, with swelling and enlargement of neck called goiter.

It affects the circulation, producing irregular distribution of blood, congestion etc. It relaxes the blood vessels causing hemorrhages which are bright or with small clots. Pallor of skin and mucous membrane alternating with flushes.

Mentally they are irritable, quiescent and intolerance of contradiction are prominent mental features. Giddiness is a constant feature, they feel as if they are balancing themselves most of the time. Everything around them grows black.

Modalities: Aggravation :- After eating & drinking, Amelioration - gently walking around. Sudden motion aggravates.

2] Ignatia :-

It produces a distinct hyperesthesia of all the senses and it is specially adapted to the nervous, rigid and apprehensive. Great dislike to contradiction. They are fault finding in the extreme.

3.] Nux Vomica :-

It is king of polycrastic remedies.

SOA :- Acts on spinal cord, brain, motor and sensory nerves, GIT, Respiratory organs, CVS, genito-urinary organs.

Pathogenesis :- Its action on spinal cord, brain, motor and sensory nerves, a condition of excessive irritability and excitability is produced which causes muscular in-coordination and paralysis.

- Unrefreshing sleep in morning.

- There is lack of balance.

- The patient is very irritable, careful, fastidious and quarrelsome.

* Homeopathic Scope and Limitation :-

Scope :-

Homeopathy has a scope in treating the anemia. It helps in hastening up the uptake of iron from the daily intake and reduce the deficiency. Simillimum is selected on the basis of constitutional similarity which includes the study of persons physical state, mental state, family tendencies and state of his present complaint. Few most commonly used medicines in

Iron deficiency anemia are - China, Ferrum met, phosphorus.

Lecithinum - This remedy has action on blood and is usually given for anemic individuals to increase the number of RBC's and amount of Hb. There will be mental exhaustion. The individual will be weak with shortness of breath, loss of flesh, forgetful, dull and confused. The headache is occiput will be pulsating type and crave for wine and coffee.

* Auxillary Management :-

- ① Eat iron rich food → Meat, eggs, leafy green vegetables, dry fruits, nuts, legumes, oats, etc.
- ② Wheat grass juice → Freshly sprouted leaves of the wheat plant, it contains chlorophyll in good amount. Chlorophyll is a great source to

stimulate and accelerate the growth of red blood cells which in turn increases the hemoglobin level.

Wheat grass provides 8 mg of iron per serving. It contains vitamin A, vitamin C, vitamin E, iron, calcium, magnesium and amino acids.

- Daily recommended intake is 30 ml.

* Follow up criteria :-

- ① Numbness and Tingling sensation should be reduced.
- ② Black spots before eyes should be reduced.
- ③ Bruising tendency should be reduced.
- ④ Slight increase in Hb concentration.
