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*Abstract: Dermatitis is a pattern of inflammation with widely diverse etiology, characterized by pruritus and oozing at some point in its history. The terms 'eczema' & 'dermatitis' are synonyms. They refer to distinctive reaction patterns in the skin which can be either acute or chronic and are due to several causes.*

#### Case Presentation:

A 10-year-old Hindu girl patient came to OPD on 14/08/2020 with c/o skin eruption for 3-4 yrs. She also c/o whitish scales, with a wet sensation. There was no itching or pain. The eruptions started from the ear and extended into the groin area. The complaint was from right to left. The patient had allopathic treatment with adequate results.

The patient also had a complaint of coryza with greenish discharge since childhood. The complaint was aggravated due to cold air and ice-cream, better by hot application.

#### Physical generals:

- Appetite: Good
- Thirst: Thirstless
- Desire: Spicy ++, Ice-cream +++, Chocolate +++
- Aversion: Bitter
- Thermal reaction: Hot

#### Mental generals:

The patient was emotional and better after consolation. She has a fear of water, a brooding tendency, and is moody. She was missing her father.
